The Los Angeles non-profit **auburn art gallery** invites photographers from around the world to submit entries for its *Landscapes* exhibition.

Landscape photography was the original way people could travel the world without ever leaving their homes. We get to see the vistas of the Grand Canyon even if we've never been – or the Great Wall of China or thousands of penguins on the tundra in Antarctica. Show us the landscapes that mean the most to you. What places do you want to share with the world?

It's the gallery's vision to bridge the gap between well-recognized photographers, excellent amateurs and those who are eager to learn. If you have a good photo, we'd love for you to submit. Simple as that!

Entry fee: \$10 for 1 photo; \$15 for 2 photos; \$25 for 4 photos; \$35 for 6 photos; \$50 for 10 photos; add \$5 for each additional photo.

How to submit: If you have photos that fit this theme, visit www.auburnartgallery.org/submissions. At that page, you can submit up to 5 photos and pay for your submissions. You may also send entries directly to matt@auburnartgallery.org. (To have your photos considered, you must pay the entry fee before the deadline. Accepted photographers will be notified soon after the deadline and should keep an eye out for an email requesting additional information. Check your spam!)

Photo criteria: Matt Harding, founder of **auburn art gallery**, will choose roughly 20-25 photos for the exhibition. They will be selected based on quality and originality. All photographic work will be reviewed; however, photography must be the primary medium. The top three images will be recognized at the gallery and on our [Flickr page](#).
